

Ingredients

400g ground beef mince 300g ground pork mince 2 slices white bread, crusts removed 1 onion 1 large egg ¼ cup milk ½ teaspoon black pepper ¼ teaspoon ground allspice ¼ teaspoon nutmeg ¼ teaspoon garlic powder ½ teaspoon salt 1 tablespoon oil (for frying)

Instructions

- 1. Preheat oven to 180 degrees Celsius.
- 2. Tear bread into pieces and place into a bowl with the milk. Leave for 5 minutes to absorb.
- 3. Place onion into food processor fitted with steel blade and pulse until finely chopped.
- 4. Add the bread and milk mixture to the food processor along with remaining meatball ingredients. Process until well combined.
- 5. Roll into golf ball-sized meatballs and set aside.
- 6. Heat oil in a large skillet over medium heat. Brown the meatballs in batches, turning occasionally.
- 7. Once meatballs have browned, place on a lined baking sheet. Cover with foil and bake for 25 minutes or until cooked through.
- 8. In the meantime, get started on the gravy. Drain off any excess oil from the skillet and melt the butter on medium heat.
- 9. Slowly whisk in flour until smooth and cook for 1 minute.
- 10. Slowly add beef stock a little at a time, whisking as you go. Bring to a simmer and continue to whisk until the gravy begins to thicken.
- 11. Return the meatballs and juices to the pan with the sauce.
- 12. Add the cream and mustard and cook for another 1-2 minutes, then remove from stove.
- 13. Serve over mashed potato and sprinkle with parsley.
